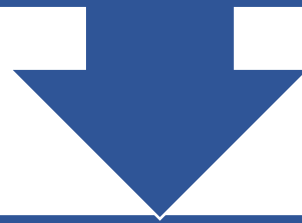

# Funding



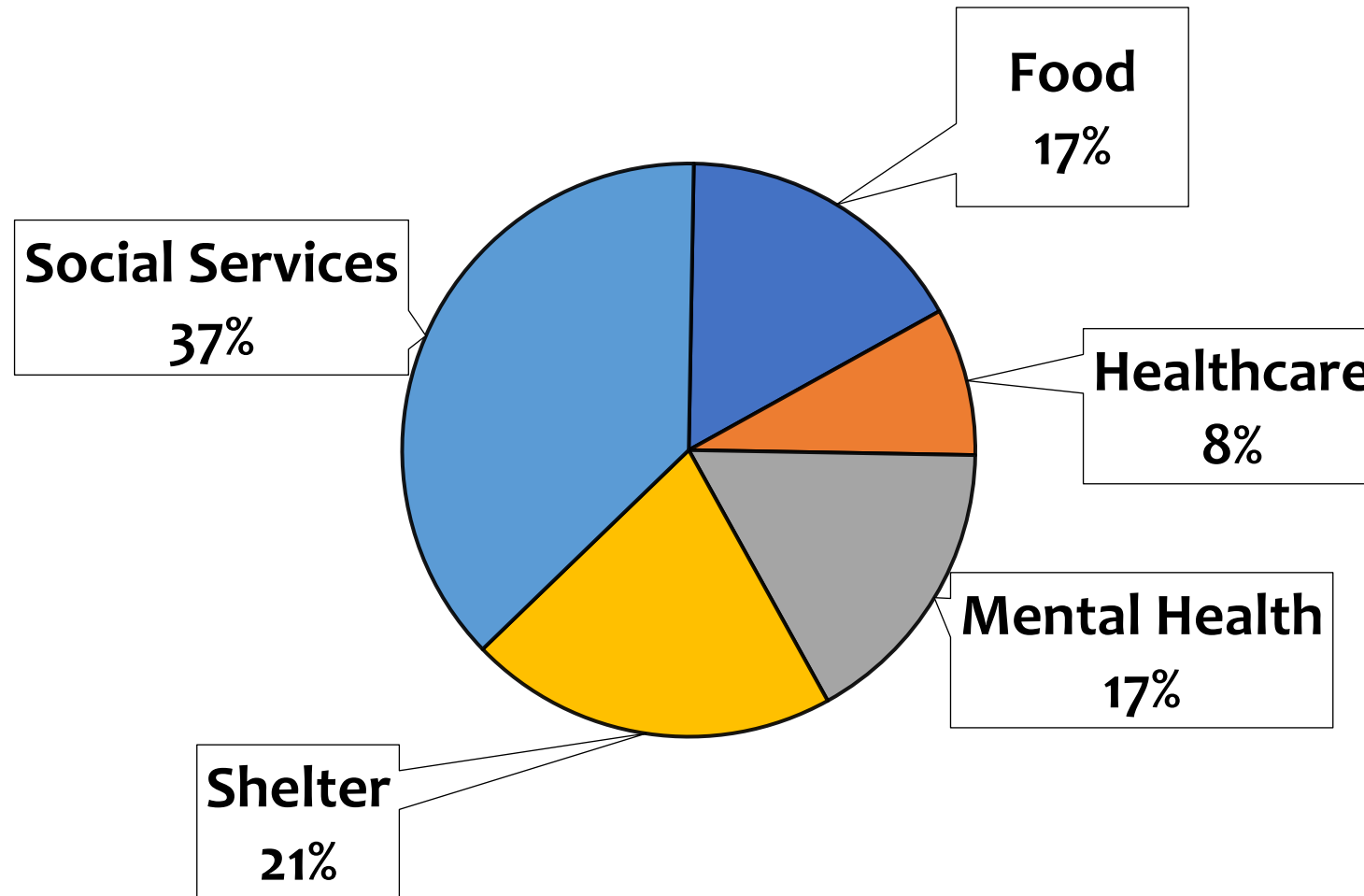
Initial contributions pledged from 5
